

THE TRAFFIC LIGHT IS ORANGE! Thanks be to God things are returning to some semblance of normality. Please still protect others from Covid or Influenza by staying at home if you are sick.

The wearing of Mask in Indoor setting is still highly recommended, and please do not put Fr Michael under pressure to have 'exceptions' to bypass safety measures imposed on him, including;

- Holy Communion is under one kind only,
- no shaking of hands (outside one's bubble during the Sign of the Peace),
- no communion on the tongue and
- no holy water available in stoops.

EASTER SUNDAY AT AMBERLEY will be celebrated by Fr Gregoire Vidal of the Beatitudes while Fr Michael celebrates it in Hanmer Springs followed by Cheviot. Please make him welcome. We them him, and also the Joyce's family for agreeing to lead the signing on this day.

THE HOLY TRIDUUM or the Holy Three days of Holy Week, namely the Masses and ceremonies of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil would have been completed by the time this is read (those who receive advance copy via email are the exceptions!). These three days require great attention to details because the liturgy is so intricate and different from a normal Sunday Mass. Thank you to everyone who had a hand in assisting Fr Michael in any way to make things lighter for him. Thank you to all who sweep or vacuum the cluster flies before others come! (see below)

FLIES-BY? If you see flies strewn all around the floors and pews in the Churches in our parish, and in particular in Amberley, Cheviot and Culverden, please do not assume that the Churches have not be swept or cleaned for ages!. We have an invasion of Cluster Flies, and it is very bad this year. Even after spraying, and 'bombing' with insecticides, and sweeping multiples time each day, the flies that came into the buildings to hibernate change their mind during the warmer part of the day, and die all around the place spending energy trying to get out along the windows. The situation will improve only after winter has peaked. Please be patient, or better still, come to Mass a little bit earlier and help sweep and earn your FLIES-BY points!

A COUPLE DAYS OF R & R after Easter is being considered by Fr Michael. It is yet to be confirmed, but likely to be Tuesday and Wednesday. Once he gets more organised, he will confirm with those who are affected, namely those who attend the 7.00am daily Mass.
