You fret about so many things....

This Sunday's Gospel (Luke 10:38-42) gives us the well known story of Mary and Martha. It is easy to judge Mary for the apparent selfishness of her conduct or Martha for the note of irritability that we detect in her complaint of her sister's lack of co-operation in the task of serving. Some people erroneously think that Martha was being criticised by Our Lord since He sighs at Martha's undue agitation. On closer reading: Our Lord said "Mary has chosen the better part". It means Martha has chosen something good too, but that Mary's choice was better. The value of quiet communion with the Lord is being stressed as something important. The point is made of the need to pay 'undivided attention' to the things that truly matter (cf. 1 Cor. 7:35) – things that endure: faith, hope and love.

Our Lord's approval of Mary's eagerness to take the opportunity to listen to His word, and be in His presence, teaches us that as His followers we cannot allow ourselves to become so preoccupied with the pursuit of external duties that we never have a moment for prayerful recollection. I'd like to think that in daily life, both are needed; i.e. being practical about the things that needed attention without neglecting the importance of things spiritual. It is easy to be bogged down with 'being busy', that we forget the need for a time of quiet and prayerful reflection.

Seek first the Kingdom of God, and by doing so, and our worldly worries are more likely to be seen in the right perspective.
