

# Courage! It is I! Do not be Afraid...

Our Christchurch contingent of World Youth Day has returned home. At the World Youth Day gathering in Lisbon last week, it is reported that 354 thousands were registered to attend. actual number for the Mass with the Pope would likely be higher. On our 6pm news, at least on this occasion, there was a quick reference to it (less than a minute?), but for many other WYD gatherings, there was no or hardly any mention of the gatherings. It just shows that for the secular media, something good happening in the Church is not deemed worthy of reporting, but, when there is



anything in the Church that involves a scandal we get the coverage! I think the secular world is afraid of the truth: that if the Church stands for what she is, and Jesus is who He is..... then, they will have to change their lives. It is better to try and find excuses or look for human brokenness in the Church to expose, so that one can find 'reasons' to justify for oneself, why one should not to look into what the Church is truly about. It is almost like the disciples who saw Our Lord walking on the lake in this Sunday's Gospel instalment: (Matthew. 14:22-33): they were also afraid. Instead of delving into His true identity, they just assumed He was a ghost. Our reassured them with the words: "Courage!, It is I, Do not be afraid". These should be His words we help people to hear, that they open themselves to God who is calling them, that they may profess what the disciples professed of Jesus at the conclusion of the episode: "Truly, You are the Son of God".

#### PARISH ADORATION NIGHT!


