

In this Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 16:21-27), Our Lord tells us; "If anyone wants to be a follower of mine, let him renounce himself and take up his cross and follow me....".

Life is a world that is broken, tarnished by sin, is full of crosses that will cross our path. There are sufferings, persecutions, martyrdoms, indifference, moral struggles, hatred.... and the list goes on. Everyone, Christian or otherwise, is bound to
