We have come to the last Sunday of the Liturgical Year, and next Sunday we start a new one with the First Sunday of Advent. If you have the Lectionary, the set of Sunday readings for Sunday Mass that will be used in the new Liturgical Year is "Year B" (There are 3 sets,

A, B and C)*. Since 1969, we have been celebrating the Last Sunday of the Liturgical year is celebrated with the Feast of Christ the King, the King of Kings. The Feast was originally established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism in which God is left out of society's thinking and living as if God did not exist. It sounds like more than ever, we are in need to inject this antidote into our society. The feast honours Our Lord as the Lord of all creation, and thus over individuals, families, society, governments, and nations. In His Divinity, He is the Creator of the Universe and wields supreme power over all things.

The nature of the Kingdom of the King of Kings is like is reflected in the words used for the liturgy which speak of it being:

- supreme,
- eternal His kingdom is forever and
- spiritual, for in His own words: His Kingdom is "not of this world".
- extended not only to people, but also to all worldly princes and kings,



FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS, an annual celebration of the Community of the Beatitudes, will be held at the Sanctuary of Fourvière on Saturday 9th December, following the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. Bishop Michael Gielen will celebrate Holy Mass at the Shrine of Mary, Mother of the Light. Mass will begin at 6pm under the large marquee.

At dusk there will be a candlelit procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Shrine where there will be adoration under the stars until benediction at dawn. SIMBANG GABI CULTURAL CELEBRATION is a nine-day series of devotional Masses celebrated in various parishes offered by the Philippine Chaplaincy of the Catholic Diocese of Christchurch. These masses are the Filipino way of preparing spiritually for Christmas, and to commemorate and honour the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ and it is an opportunity for everyone to experience something wonderful.

One of the Masses will be in Culverden at 7pm Mass as a Saturday Vigil Mass on the 23rd December. The 23rd is the 4th Sunday of the month, which means there is normally no Mass in Culverden but a Sunday Mass in Hawarden. However, because of this Mass, Hawarden is cancelled.
