Second Sunday of Advent

Prepare the way



'Prepare a way for the Lord, make his paths straight'— is the message of the Second Sunday of Advent. They are the words of St John the Baptist (Mark 1:1-8). He himself was a precursor to the coming of Christ, prepare a way for His coming.

10 December 2023

John makes his appearance in the wilderness while proclaiming a baptism for the repentance of sins. His clothing is reminiscent of the prophet Elijah (2 Kings 1:8). In fact, he is regarded as the 'new Elijah'.

John's message is similar to the message of the Old Testament prophets, chiding the People of God for their unfaithfulness to awaken repentance in them. Among those unconcerned with the coming of God's Kingdom with the coming of Christ, it was John's task to awaken their interest, to unsettle them from the complacency, and to arouse in them goodwill. His message still rings true in our time. His task is also our task: we too are called to give testimony to the light and truth of Christ, pointing others to Christ in the way we live, work, and speak. Advent is the good time to open our hearts to John's message that our Christmas preparation, and celebration, be more than a 'commercial' event.
