#### Third Sunday of Advent

Year B

#### Gaudete! Rejoice!

If you have the Roman Missal, or read in advance the Scripture readings on the lectern, you would find that for every Mass, there is an "Entrance Antiphon". For the third Sunday of Advent the Entrance Antiphon is: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near". (Phil 4: 4-5). It is from this antiphon that the third Sunday of Advent is traditionally called Gaudete Sunday, or 'Rejoice" Sunday (Rejoice = Gaudete in Latin).



The call to 'Rejoice', marked by the lighting of the pink candle on the Advent wreathe, is a reminder that the feast of the Lord's

coming is now near, spiritually and literally (Christmas is only a few sleeps away!). In this context of joyful anticipation, this Sunday's Gospel (John 1:6-8, 19-28) urges us to meditate again on St. John the Baptist. Last Sunday we were already presented with the figure of John the Baptist where he was crying out for us to 'prepare a way for the Lord'. This Sunday the Gospel passage reveals to us the mission of the Baptist, described now as "a man... sent from God", that is, God's "missionary", who "came for testimony, to testify to the light," Jesus, the divine Word. John is also very clear; he is neither the Christ, nor the prophet Elijah. He claims for himself only the humble role of a herald of someone greater who is to come after him someone who he is not fit to undo His sandals. Contrast this clarity of identity, and calling in life, with that of Adam and Eve. They ate the forbidden fruit because they wanted to be like God, and wanted to usurp the role of God. There is that tendency in all of us, who are tarnished by sin, to want to be like God!

We can learn from John the Baptist; that is, to have the clarity of mind of knowing who God is and who we are, and of pointing others to God.
