From the Heart

THIS STORY is told about a bishop who made a pastoral visit and was impressed to see his picture hanging in the presbytery. Not only that, his picture was clean, while all the other pictures were full of cobwebs. He commended without end the parish priest for this, until the parish priest spoke up and said "Actually, Bishop, I heard you were coming and I hanged your picture one hour before you arrived."

In today's Gospel [MK.7 1-8, 14-15, 21-23] Jesus criticises the hypocrisy of the Jews, particularly the Scribes and the Pharisees who "disregard God's commandment but cling to human tradition." For Jesus what is important is the heart, not the externals. "Nothing that enters one from outside can defile that person but the things that come out from within are what defile."

A love song says it so well: "Your lips may be sweet, but where is your heart?" Whenever we speak to people, we must speak with the heart. More so, whenever we speak to God, we must speak with the heart because prayer is a heart-to-heart moment with God.

Hypocrisy is learned, and by golly, some people are fast learners. In fact, they become so good at it that soon, it becomes almost second-nature to them without even their knowing it. But the hypocrite emeritus are those who no longer care about public opinion or about God's opinion because for them, all that matters is that "The Show" must go on.

A lot of things can be faked these days. These are days of piracy and imitations. It is getting difficult to distinguish what is fake and what is real. However, the true colour of a person, the real character of a person cannot be hidden. It will show after a while. And all of us have a sixth sense which makes us recognise who is fake and who is real.

God requires a piety which involves not only our prayers but also our conduct and behaviour. One without the other is hypocritical. And that is why the Lord reserved the harshest criticism for the Pharisees. May He not say of us: "This people honour Me with their lips, but their hearts are far from Me."

Lord, let everything I say or do come from the heart. Amen.

Baltimore Catechism

Q. 139. How is the Church enabled to lead men to salvation?

A. The Church is enabled to lead men to salvation by the indwelling of the Holy Ghost, who gives it life.

Although the work of salvation is the result of the operation of all three Persons of the Blessed Trinity, it is especially the result of the Redemption by Christ, and because this work is one of divine love it is attributed to the Holy Ghost, who is the soul of the Church, of which Christ is the Head.

Q. 152. Which is the one true Church established by Christ?

A. The one true Church established by Christ is the Catholic Church.

Many churches which claim to be Christian have broken away from the one true Church established by Jesus Christ. These churches were founded by men who had no authority from God to found a church. Christ intended that there should be only one true Christian Church, for He always spoke of His Church as one.

Q. 153. How do we know that the Catholic Church is the one true Church established by Christ?

A. We know that the Catholic Church is the one true Church established by Christ because it alone has the marks of the true Church.

Q. 155. What are the chief marks of the Church?

A. The chief marks of the Church are four: It is one, holy, catholic or universal, and apostolic.

Sacred Scripture teaches that the one true Church of Christ must have these marks. The marks of the Church are themselves an indication that God guides the Church.
